8. PERIOD OF DEPUTATION (INCLUDING SHORT TERM CONTRACT) & CONTRACT:

- (a) The normal **deputation tenure** for Coach and Senior Coach is 3 years, Chief Coach is 4 years and High Performance Coach is 5 years, which can be extended up to 7 years (as per Recruitment Rules of SAI), depending on the requirements, or till the age of 60 years, whichever is earlier. The personnel may be repatriated pre-maturely if the performance is not found to be satisfactory.
- (b) The initial contract shall be for a period of one year and extendable in a cycle of one year subject to a maximum age of 65 years. However, the contract can be terminated by giving a 30 days' notice period by either party i.e. SAI and the employee. In extreme cases the contract can be terminated by SAI with immediate effect without notice period. The other terms & conditions necessary for appointment in SAI will be mentioned in the detailed agreement that shall be signed by the selected candidate at the time of appointment.

9. INSTRUCTIONS ON RESERVATION: (FOR CONTRACTUAL ENGAGEMENTS)

- I. Reservation will be made for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes and the Economically Weaker Sections in respect of vacancies as may be fixed by the Sports Authority of India.
- II. Relaxation in Age limit for SC/ST/OBC/Ex-Serviceman shall be as per DoPT OM No. 15012/2/2010- Estt(D) dated 27.03.2012.
- III. Eligibility for Availing Reservation:

- a) A candidate will be eligible to get the benefit of community reservation only in case the particular caste to which the candidate belongs is included in the list of reserved communities issued by the Central Government.
- b) The OBC candidates applying for must produce OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) certificate based on the income for the Financial Year (FY) 2020-2021, 2019-2020 and 2018-19.
- c) A candidate will be eligible to get the benefit of the Economically Weaker Section reservation only in case the candidate meets the criteria issued by the Central Government and is in possession of requisite Income & Asset Certificate based on income for Financial Year (FY) 2020-2021.
- d) Candidates seeking reservation/relaxation benefits available for SC/ST/OBC/EWS must ensure that they are entitled to such reservation/relaxation as per eligibility. They should also be in possession of all the requisite certificates in the prescribed format in support of their claim as stipulated in the Rules/Notice for such benefits by the closing date of the application.
- e) The closing date fixed for the receipt of the applications of this advertisement will be treated as the date for determining the OBC status (including that of creamy layer) of the candidates.
- IV. Candidates must ensure the community certificates that are to be produced for availing SC/ST/OBC/EWS reservation are as per standard format and proforma issued from time to time. (Sample proformas and format are attached to this advertisement.)

- (iv) Sub Divisional Officer of the area where the candidate and/or his/her family normally resides.
- (v) Administrator/Secretary to Administrator/Development Officer(Lakshadweep)
